ORS Seeks to Intervene in Civil Action Against SCE&G

The South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff (ORS) filed a motion to intervene in a civil action brought against South Carolina Electric & Gas Company.

Because of the tremendous impact of the VC Summer Units 2 & 3 abandonment and the Base Load Review Act on the state and its citizens, the ORS is seeking to intervene in this civil action. Established in 2004, the ORS is charged with representing the public interest in utility regulation before the Public Service Commission of S.C., the court system, the S.C. General Assembly, and federal regulatory bodies.

According to the ORS' petition filed in this Action (No. 2017-CP-40-04833), "...this case could affect the rates or service of South Carolina Electric & Gas Company and substantially affects the public interest in prior decisions and actions by the South Carolina Public Service Commission."

The Office of Regulatory Staff is an agency of the State of South Carolina. Its mission is to represent the public interest in utility regulation by balancing the concerns of the using and consuming public, the financial integrity of public utilities, and the economic development of South Carolina.
