

FAQs – Act 258

Q1: When will I see a reduction in my SCE&G electric bill?

A1: You will see a reduction in your electric bill beginning with the first billing cycle of August 2018, presuming there is no suspension of SC Public Service Commission Order Nos. 2018-459 and 2018-460 implementing Act 258.

Q2: How much will my electric bill be per month with this reduction?

A2: SCE&G's residential customers, served on Rate 8, using 1,000 kWh will pay an average of \$125.34 per month beginning with the first billing cycle of August 2018. This is a reduction of \$22.36 a month from the prior rates.

Q3: I am an SCE&G customer for both electric and gas. Will I receive a reduction for gas as well?

A3: No, the reduction is only for electricity charges.

Q4: Is this reduction permanent?

A4: No. The SC Public Service Commission is scheduled to hold a hearing beginning November 1, 2018, to determine permanent rates.

Q5: How much will SCE&G continue to be authorized to collect each month?

A5: SCE&G will be able to collect \$77,636,491 on an annual basis and \$6,469,708 on a monthly basis under Docket No. 2018-217-E.
